# "Ought"

"He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked."

#### Ought – to be under obligation.

- ✓ Man is created with a duty Ecclesiastes 12:13 (KJV)
- ✓ Man is under a universal authority Matthew 28:18; Acts 2:34-38
- ✓ There is but one way to God, and man ought to go that way *Matthew 7:13-14; John 14:6*

## "Himself"

"He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked."

#### Himself – personalizes the obligation.

- ✓ Each must bear his own load *Galatians 6:5*
- ✓ Each will be judged on whether he has carried out his obligation *Ecclesiastes 12:13-14; Romans 2:6, 11*
- ✓ Each must work out his own salvation *Philippians 2:12*
- ✓ Each must be given to constant introspection 2 Corinthians 13:5

### "Also to walk"

"He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked."

# Also to walk – connection of the statement of theory with the obligation in action.

- ✓ The theory must both be heard and applied James 1:22-25
- ✓ Faith must be shown with works James 2:14-18, 26
- ✓ The obligation must be acknowledged and fulfilled *Luke 6:46; Matthew 7:21-23*
- ✓ The walk must be continual until the end is met *Hebrews 4:9-10;*John 9:4-5

### "Just as"

"He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked."

## Just as – restricts the obligation of walking to a specific standard.

- ✓ There is only one way and truth that brings the one life John 14:6
- ✓ The words which communicate the obligation must not be altered
  - Deuteronomy 4:2
- ✓ To alter the words is to alter your outcome *Leviticus 10:1-3;* Numbers 20:7-12
- ✓ Every branch must bear fruit JUST AS the vine or else it is not of the vine John 15:1-2; Matthew 7:15-20

### "He walked"

"He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked."

#### He walked – the standard identified.

- ✓ Christ is the standard of imitation 1 Corinthians 11:1
- ✓ Christ is known through His words and commandments 1 John 2:3-6
- ✓ Only those who abide in His word are His disciples *John 8:31-32*
- ✓ There is no gray area. Christ is light 1 John 1:5-7; 2:1
- ✓ To deviate from the standard is to sin, and one must repent, confess, and ask forgiveness to get back to the walk 1 John 1:8-10; 5:14-17
