

By Faith Abel...

Faith is More than Conviction, it is Directed Conduct Account of sacrifice – Genesis 4:1-5 "By faith" indicates it was done in accordance with God's instruction – Romans 10:17 (cf. Genesis 4:7, LXX) Our actions are only "excellent" if they are directed by God's will – Ephesians 2:10; 2 Timothy 3:16-17



By Faith Abel...

Our Righteousness is Confirmed or Denied by God's Word God testifying of Abel's gift – Genesis 4:4-5 God's word bears witness with our attitude toward Him, and obedience to Him that we are His faithful children – Romans 8:15-16 The spiritual man will be subject to God's law – Romans 8:2, 7, 9 We need to examine ourselves to see if we are in subjection to God's word – 2 Corinthians 13:5



By Faith Abel...

Faith Can Anger the Unfaithful

Abel was murdered by his brother because his deeds were righteous, but those of his brother were evil – Genesis 4:8; 1 John 3:11-12

Darkness hates the light – John 3:19-21

We should not allow such to cause us to stumble, but persist in godliness – John 15:18; 16:1; 1 Peter 3:13-14



By Faith Abel...

Faith Leaves a Legacy

Through his "more excellent" sacrifice, Abel still speaks although dead – Hebrews 11:4

We can continue to positively affect others in the future by the life we are living now – Hebrews 11:2; 13:7



By Faith Enoch...

Faith Requires a Willingness to Change

- Enoch did not always walk by faith Genesis 5:21-24 began at 65 after the birth of his son.
- God requires repentance Acts 17:30 repentance is an act of faith.
- Doing God's will is what matters, and God will reward anyone who decides to start living by faith regardless of when they start – Matthew 21:28-31; 20:8-16



By Faith Enoch...

Faith Requires Outspokenness
Enoch prophesied for God – Jude 14-15
The Hebrews were encouraged to be outspoken (confident) in their faith – Hebrews 10:35
Our faith is not to be kept to ourselves – Matthew 10:27-28, 32-33; Acts 8:4



By Faith Enoch...

God May Spare the Faithful from Some Difficulty God took Enoch early, without death, about mid-life – *Hebrews 11:5*Enoch and Lamech, both 7th sons from Adam (Seth and Cain) show the early divide in humankind – *Genesis 4:16-24; 5:22*In being taken by God Enoch was spared from experiencing the spiritual decline in the world.

It is a blessing to depart and be with the Lord – *Philippians 1:21, 23; Psalm 116:15*



By Faith Noah...

Faith Acts on God's Word, Not the Status Quo
Noah had followed God up to the point of the judgment on the ungodly world – *Genesis 6:5-9, 13, 17*The scoffers in Peter's day trusted in the status quo – *2 Peter 3:3-7*Noah trusted God's words and acted accordingly. He did so for a great period of time – *Genesis 6:3*



By Faith Noah...

Faith Gives Attention to Detail in Fear of God
Noah obeyed God in everything God instructed – Genesis 6:22
Such action was energized by godly fear – Hebrews 11:7
The Hebrews were warned about resisting God's word – Hebrews 12:25, 28-29; 2:1-4

Noah was given specific instructions regarding the ark – Genesis 6:14-16 – he obeyed them all.

We are to hold fast the pattern of sound words in faith – 2 Timothy 1:13



By Faith Noah...

Faith Affects Families for the Better Noah saved his household by his actions – Hebrews 11:7; 1 Peter 3:20

Faith, or lack thereof, will drastically affect the spiritual direction of the family for the better or the worse – Joshua 24:15

Faith Will Naturally Condemn the Unfaithful

✤God's design is for His people to display their faith to bring godly sorrow on others – Matthew 5:13-16; 1 Peter 2:11-12; 3:16; 2 Corinthians 7:10
