He Loved the Unlovable

- Agapao love cf. Matthew 5:43-48
- God loved us, and Christ loved us John 3:16; Ephesians 5:25

He Paid the Ultimate Price

- "Gave Himself" Philippians 2:3-8; Acts 20:28; 1 Peter 1:18-19
- "For Her" Ephesians 5:23; Acts 2:38, 40-41, 47

Sanctified and Cleansed Her

The Purpose

- Sanctify hagiazo "set it apart" (marginal, NKJV) "signifies to set apart for God, to sanctify, to make a person or thing the opposite of koinos, 'common'" (VINE)
 - Negative Colossians 1:13; John 17:14-19
 - Positive 1 Peter 2:4-5, 9-10
- Cleanse John 15:3; 17:17; 2 Corinthians 6:14-7:1

Sanctified and Cleansed Her

The Process

- "with the washing of water by the word"
- Word Ephesians 6:17; 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14
- Washing of water *Titus 3:5; John 3:3, 5; 1 Peter 1:22-23; 3:21; Hebrews 10:22*

Nourishing and Cherishing Her

Marriage Custom

- Betrothal.
- God's blessings.
- Interval between betrothal and wedding feast.
 - Dowry paid if not already.
- Preparation and procession for wedding feast:
 - Bride prepares and adorns self.
 - Groom in best attire, friends accompanying, proceed to home of betrothed.
 - Receives bride and proceeds to place of feast.
- Wedding feast.

Nourishing and Cherishing Her

The Bride's Preparation

- Christ to church:
 - Nourishes and cherishes cf. 1 Thessalonians 2:4-9
 - Preparing to present bride glorious, no spot/wrinkle, holy without blemish *Ephesians 3:20-21; 1:22-23; 1 Corinthians 5:7*
- How the bride is prepared:
 - God's word, and gifts 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Ephesians 4:11-16; 1 Timothy 3:14-15
 - Prepares herself Revelation 19:7-8; Philippians 2:12-13; 1 Thessalonians 2:13

Leading Her

Headship of Christ

- He is head of the church Ephesians 1:22-23; 5:23
- Authority, preeminence Colossians 1:18; 2:6-7, 9-10; 3:17
- For our benefit *Ephesians 5:23, 25*
