- "Goodness" expressed toward man in saving them from their sins
 - Ephesians 2:4-8; Titus 3:4-7; Romans 2:4

The Goodness of God is the Provision of Salvation

The Severity of God is the Reason for the Gospel

- God's wrath is the reason men need saving Romans 1:18
- God is holy, and sin separates man from Him 1 John 1:5;
 Isaiah 59:1-2; Romans 6:23
- The goodness of God was poured out in the darkness of severity Romans 3:23-26; 8:3; Isaiah 53:4-6

CONSIDER THE GOODNESS AND SEVERITY OF GOD

The Reality of Both is Cause for Serious Thought

- God is giving us fair warning Romans 11:19-23
- God is impartial in His administration of both Romans 2:6-11
- The conditions for both are universal Romans 1:16
- We must make sure we are aligned with God's goodness –
 2 Corinthians 13:5
