

By Faith the Israelites...

- Faith Moves Forward at God's Word
- Leading up to the crossing of the Red Sea Exodus 14:1-4, 10-18, 21-22
- Moses' command to "stand still" Exodus 14:13-14 faith is not overwhelmed with outward circumstances, but stands still in recognition of God's power and provision – Job 37:14; Psalm 46:1-3, 10-11; Matthew 6:30-34
- However, faith is not idle, but acts on God's word Exodus 14:15; Luke 5:4-5; 6:46-49



By Faith the Israelites...

Faith is Not Presumptuous

In the same verse, the Hebrew writer notes the severity of God upon the Egyptians – Romans 11:22; Hebrews 11:29

- The difference in the crossing of the Israelites and the attempt of the Egyptians was faith produced by God's word.
- Spiritual endeavors are only successful when they are directed by God's word – Matthew 7:21-23



By Faith the Israelites...

Faith Counts God's Foolishness as Wisdom

The instructions of God for Israel in advancing on Jericho were not militarily sound, and seem foolish without context – Joshua 6:1-5

The walls fell due to their faithful obedience – Hebrews 11:30

- Faith always trusts in God's ways Isaiah 55:8-11
- Even when the world thinks it foolishness 1 Corinthians 1:18-25

Faith becomes a fool to become wise – 1 Corinthians 3:18-20



By Faith Rahab...

Faith Yields to Indisputable Evidence

- Only Rahab and her family were spared in Israel's attack on Jericho Hebrews 11:31
- Jericho was fortified Numbers 13:19; Joshua 2:15
- It did not matter how big their wall was, Rahab feared because of her belief in the news of Jehovah and Israel – Joshua 2:8-9
- When a message is presented and proven to be God's word, faith accepts, and acts Acts 17:11-12

By Faith Rahab...

Faith Can Overcome Any Past

The writer did not neglect to mention Rahab's occupation – Hebrews 11:31; Proverbs 6:24-29; 7:10-20

There is more glory brought to God in the fact of one such as Rahab the harlot being changed by God's power through faith – James 2:25

Faith trusts in God's promise of forgiveness, and pursues it with fervid penitence – 1 Timothy 1:13-16; 1 Corinthians 5:1, 5; 2 Corinthians 2:6-7; 7:10-11
