Torveness Siveness

- Aphiemi (apo, "from," hiemi, "to send"); "to send forth, send away"; "to remit or forgive" (VINE) (cf. Psalm 103:12)
- Charizomai 1) to do something pleasant or agreeable (to one), to do a favor to, gratify; 1b) to grant forgiveness, to pardon. (THAYER)

The Need

The Sin of Man

- All have sinned Romans 3:23; 1 John 3:4; Ecclesiastes 12:13
- The need for forgiveness is universal, but is on an individual basis Ezekiel 18:20
- The gospel convicts each individual of sin to emphasize their need for forgiveness Romans 3:9, 19-20; 11:32



The Penalty of Sin

- The wages of sin is death Romans 3:23; Isaiah 59:1-2; 2 Thessalonians 1:8-9
- All sin will be punished equally Revelation 21:8



Forgiveness Must be Desired to be Obtained

- Not all desire forgiveness.
 - Pride/self-righteousness Luke 18:11-12; James 4:6-10
 - ❖Blinded by Satan and his devices 2 Corinthians 4:3-4



The Desire for a Pure Conscience

- ❖The guilt of sin weighs on the soul *Psalm 32:3-4*
- ❖It is always before the tender heart, and such seeks relief
 Psalm 51:3-4, 10
- A good conscience leads to confidence with God 1 John 3:20-21

The Desire for Restored Favor with God

- Psalm 51:12; 2 Chronicles 7:14

The Origin

The Main Victim

- Forgiveness is to be sought from the person you offended *Matthew 5:23-24*
- However, in any sin God is the main victim Psalm 51:4;
 Genesis 39:9
- Forgiveness from another may not be possible. Forgiveness of self is truly meaningless. Only forgiveness from God can truly rectify sin.



Blood

- No remission without shed blood Hebrews 9:22 ("remission" aphesis "forgiveness," NASB)
- Life is in the blood Leviticus 17:11; 4:15-20 atonement and forgiveness provided.
- ❖Blood of animals is insufficient Hebrews 10:1-4



The Blood of Christ

- ❖How much more shall the blood of Christ cleanse the conscience from dead works? – Hebrews 9:11-14; 10:11-18 ("remission," 9:22)
- ❖Blood of Christ is the purchase price Acts 20:28; 1 Peter 1:18-19
- Forgiveness should not be taken for granted -Hebrews 10:26-29



The Glory of God

- To the praise of the glory of God Ephesians 1:3-7, 12
- Appeal to God's nature for forgiveness Psalm 51:1
- The gospel plan of salvation leading to forgiveness is of Him, through Him, and TO Him *Romans 11:32-36*

The Restoration of Man to the Glory of God

The church is to the glory of God - Colossians 1:13-14; Ephesians 3:20-21



The range of God's forgiveness can be understood with the purpose of such.

- ❖Limited mercy? Psalm 103:17
- ❖Limited power? Matthew 19:25-26

The only sin that cannot be forgiven is the one without repentance – 1 John 5:16-17
