Inspiration Demonstrated

- Moses and Aaron Exodus 4:13-17; 7:1
- ❖ Jeremiah *Jeremiah 1:4-9*
- ❖ Balaam *Numbers 22:18, 38; 23:5; 24:13*
- ❖ Scripture quoted in the New Testament − *Mark 12:35-37;*Acts 1:16; 28:25-27; Hebrews 3:7; 10:15-17

THE INSPIRATION OF SCRIPTURE

The System of Inspiration

- ❖The Holy Spirit moved men to speak the words of God − 2 Peter 1:19-21
 - ❖ Did not require the full understanding of the prophet − 1 Peter 1:10-12; Acts 2:39; 10:34-35
- Mystery revealed by the Holy Spirit through apostles and prophets
 - Ephesians 3:3-5

THE INSPIRATION OF SCRIPTURE

The System of Inspiration

- The degree of inspiration:
 - ❖ Plenary (complete) 2 Timothy 3:16
 - ❖ Verbal (words) 1 Corinthians 2:10-13 (v. 13, NASB);
 EX: Matthew 22:32 ("I am")
- If not "plenary," who decides which is inspired and which is not?
- If not "verbal," God placed an important plan in the hands of fallible men to communicate with their own words.

IMPLICATIONS OF INSPIRATION

Total Belief is Required

- Example: The Sadducees not believing in the resurrection Acts 23:6-8; Matthew 22:23-33
- Creation not figurative, but 6 literal days Matthew 19:4 Jesus said, "at the beginning." (What about John 6?)
- **❖Universal flood** not local 2 Peter 3:3-6 "world…perished, being flooded." (What about judgment and destruction at the coming of Christ? vv. 7, 10)
- Heaven, hell, all doctrine, all sin, etc.

IMPLICATIONS OF INSPIRATION

Scripture Cannot Be Broken

- ❖ 2 Timothy 1:13; 2:15 must hold fast the pattern, and rightly divide.
- The scripture cannot be broken (rejected, ignored, changed, contradicted, challenged) John 10:31-39 (cf. Psalm 82)
- ❖ When men try to break the scripture *Matthew 21:42-44* they are broken instead.
- Plan of salvation, work/worship/organization of the church, fellowship parameters, design of the home, etc.
