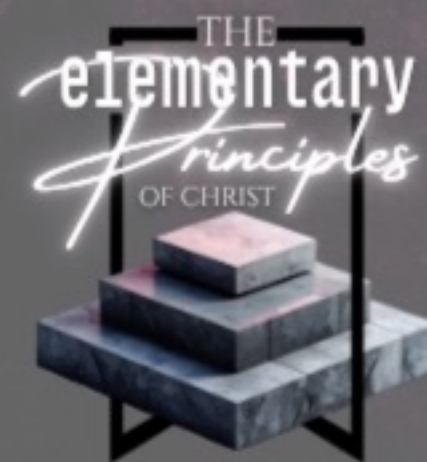


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What is the eternal judgment?

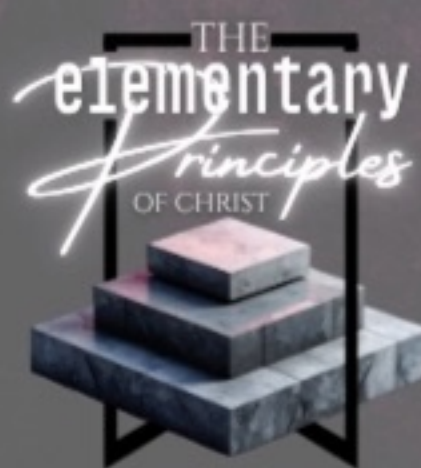
- **Judgments in Time** — Romans 1:18, 32; Proverbs 14:34; Daniel 5:21-31; Isaiah 24:1-6
- **Eternal Judgment** — John 5:22-23, 28-30; Matthew 18:8-9; 25:31-34, 41, 46; Revelation 20:11-14
- **The Day of the Lord Will Come** — 2 Peter 3



The Eternal Judgment

The Standard of Judgment

- Judgment is not arbitrary (cf. **Isaiah 24:5**).
- Jesus said His word would judge — **John 12:48**
- Transgression and disobedience to God's word receives just reward — **Hebrews 2:1-4**
- The word judges — **Hebrews 3:16-19; 4:1-2, 11-12**
(**Deuteronomy 8:1-4, 19-20**)



The Eternal Judgment

The Nature of Judgment

- Judgment is universal — John 5:28-29; Acts 17:30-31; Romans 14:11-12; 2 Corinthians 5:9-11; Romans 2:3
- Judgment is impartial — Rom. 2:4-11; Acts 10:34-35; Eph. 6:9
- Judgment is just — Psalm 51:3-4; 19:9; Hebrews 4:13; 1 Timothy 5:24-25
- Judgment is final — Hebrews 6:2



The Eternal Judgment

The Preparation for Judgment

- The reality of judgment shapes how we live — **Ecclesiastes 11:9-10; 12:13-14; Acts 24:15-16, 24-25**
- In respect to the law's revelation and how we treat others — **James 2:12-13; Matthew 6:14-15**
- We must prepare — **2 Timothy 2:19; 2 Peter 3:14; 1 John 2:28-29; 4:17-19**



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
